WHAT IS CHANGE THE FUTURE WV?

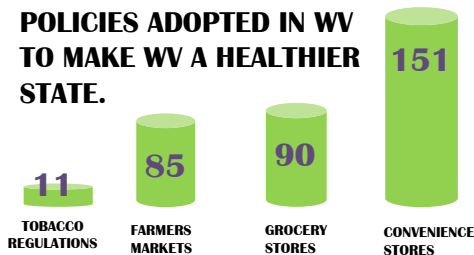
In 2011, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention awarded Community Transformation Grants (CTG) around the nation to support neighborhoods, school districts, villages, towns, cities, and counties to increase opportunities to prevent chronic diseases and promote health. In an effort to reach more people, approximately \$70 million was awarded to 40 states or communities to implement broad, sustainable strategies that will reduce health disparities and expand clinical and community preventive services. In WV, this initiative was called Change the Future WV (CTFW). 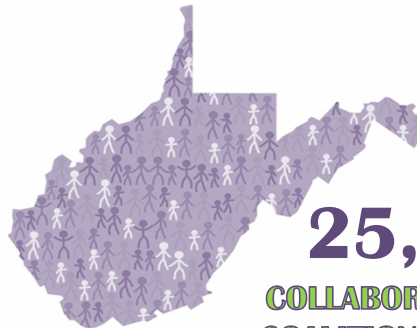
