**American Health Information Management Association (AHIMA) Merit Scholarships** - One of the major initiatives of the Foundation is to attract and support new talent in the health information management (HIM) industry by improving educational opportunities for current and future HIM professionals through scholarships. The foundation offers merit scholarships to currently enrolled outstanding undergraduates in HIM and health information technology (HIT) as well as those professionals pursuing master's or doctoral degrees in areas related to health information. **Application Due Date: September 30, 2017.**

**Horowitz Foundation for Social Policy Research Grants** - The Horowitz Foundation for Social Policy was established in 1997 to support the advancement of research and understanding in the major fields of the social sciences, which include psychology, anthropology, sociology, economics, urban affairs, area studies, political science, and other disciplines. Through its grants program, the foundation awards grants of \$7,500 to individuals in support of projects that address contemporary issues in the social sciences. Recipients will receive \$5,000 at the start of the project and \$2,500 at its completion.

Applicants are not required to be a citizen or resident of the United States. Grant awards are limited, however, to aspiring PhD students at the dissertation level whose project has received approval from their appropriate department head/university. **Application Due Date: December 1, 2017.**
