American Association of University Women (AAUW)--International Fellowships are awarded for full-time study or research in the United States to women who are not U.S. citizens or permanent residents. Both graduate and postgraduate studies at accredited U.S. institutions are supported. Recipients are selected for academic achievement and demonstrated commitment to women and girls. Recipients return to their home countries to become leaders in business, government, academia, community activism, the arts, and sciences.

Fellowships are available for study in the USA. A limited number of awards are available to women who are members of the International Federation of University Women for study in any country other than their own. **Due dates for Applications for AAUW**International Fellowships are open August 1–December
