Nancy Sanders Memorial Student and Faculty Travel and Research Abroad Grants - In honor of the legacy of long-time staff member in WVU's Global Health Program, the Global Engagement Office (GEO) at Health Sciences is pleased to announce that the application period for the Nancy Sanders Memorial Student Travel Grant and the Nancy Sanders Memorial Faculty Research Abroad Grant is now open. Nancy was instrumental in establishing WVU's highly successful and nationally distinguished Tropical Medicine Course. She enjoyed meeting people from all over the world, and she made every visitor feel welcomed and loved. In the same spirit of her tireless work, hospitality and kindness, the GEO administers these grants to support the development and cultivation of international collaborations for faculty and students. Up to ten student awards of \$2,000.00 each are available for the academic year. One of these ten student awards is prioritized for an outbound placement through the Global Health Learning Opportunities (GHLO) program of the Association of American Medical Colleges (AAMC). SOPHE 21st Century Student Scholarship - This award provides conference support to full-time undergraduate and graduate level students to attend SOPHE's Annual Conference [spring] or Advocacy Summit [fall]. Scholarship support can include any combination of registration fee to the conference or summit and any real and reasonable travel expenses incurred, as per federal per diem, and lodging at the official event hotel or a substitute hotel, not to exceed the cost of the assigned event hotel. SOPHE also encourages and allows conference/advocacy support funds to be used for supplemental SOPHE chapter membership. Total support cannot exceed \$500 and will be reimbursed upon submission of receipts and required travel reimbursement form following the event. **Application Due Date: September 30,**

P.E.O. International Scholars Awards - P.E.O. Scholar Awards are one-time, competitive, merit-based awards for women of the United States and Canada who are pursuing a doctoral level degree at an accredited college or university. In addition to recognizing and encouraging excellence in higher education, these awards provide partial support for study and research for women who will make significant contributions in their varied fields of endeavor. **Application Due Date: November 20,**

Vivian Drenckhahn Student Scholarship- This \$1,500 scholarship is awarded annually to two deserving full-time undergraduate or graduate students who are national SOPHE members and who have excelled academically, demonstrated a commitment to addressing the public's health through a career in health education, and who have demonstrated financial need. Students applying for this award must currently be pursuing a health education degree (e.g., health education, community health education, public health education, school health education), and must have completed at least one-third of coursework required for their major. This award is designated for tuition support and is paid directly to the student's academic institution. Applications are accepted every summer/fall. **Application Due Date: September 30,**

Graduate Student Research Paper - Every year, SOPHE recognizes one outstanding graduate student for creative and innovative research as illustrated by completion of a research paper. The recipient will receive a \$250 and complimentary registration at the SOPHE Annual Conference, where they are invited to give a conference poster or presentation. Applications are accepted every summer/fall. This award fosters quality graduate student research and provides a mechanism by which to recognize outstanding graduate students for creative and innovative research. The award recipient is encouraged to submit the paper for review to one of SOPHE's journals: *Health*

The Delbert Oberteuffer Scholarship - This \$1,500 scholarship, presented by SOPHE on behalf of the Foundation for the Advancement of Health Education (FAHE), recognizes doctoral students for their academic achievement; applicant's potential for advancing the health of children and youth; professional goals; and the caliber of the documents. The Oberteuffer Scholarship is open to doctoral level students who are currently enrolled in a health education program in the United States or a U.S. territory. The award will be presented during SOPHE's Annual Conference. The applicant must be currently enrolled in an accredited college/university in the United States or a U.S. territory in a health education program and be able to demonstrate six (6) completed credit hours in the program of study. **Applications are accepted every summer/fall.
