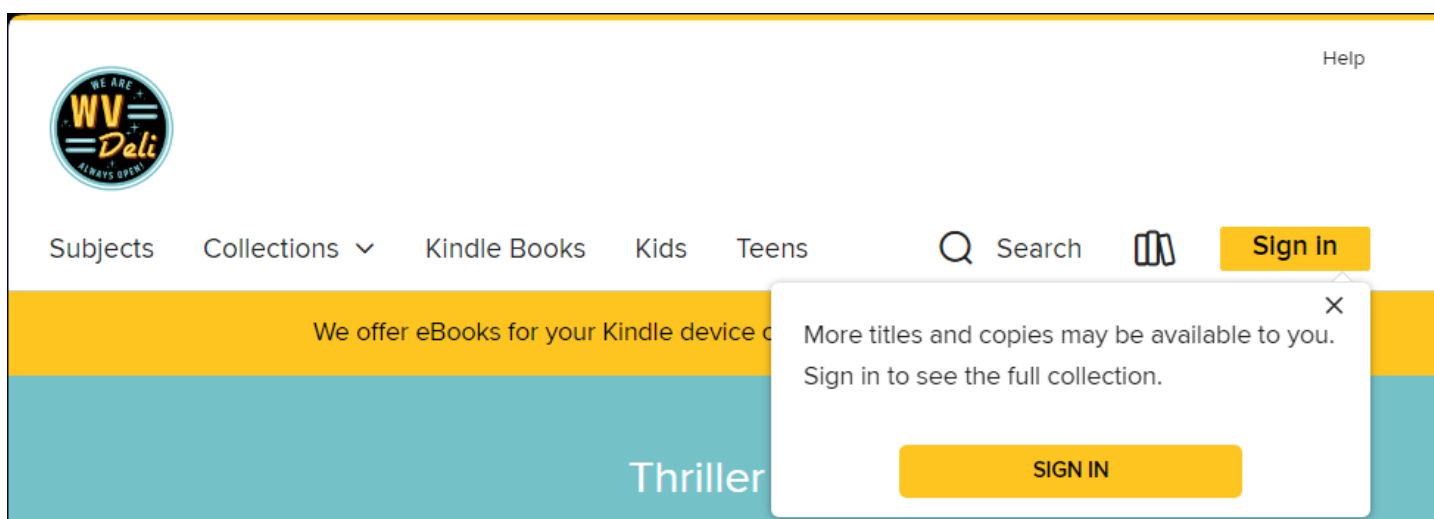

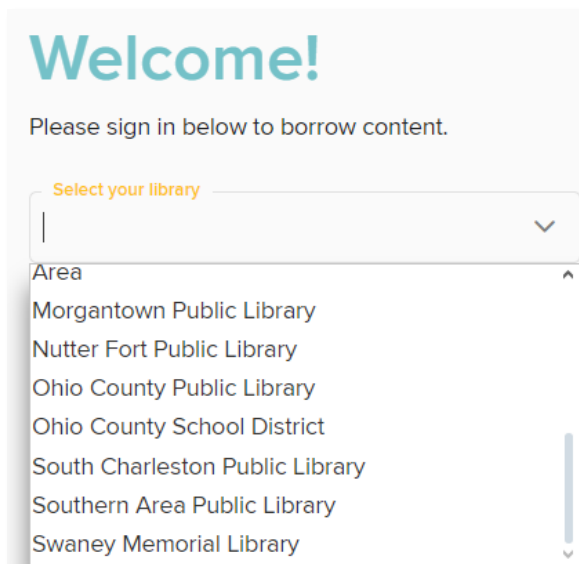
To access your local library online, you'll need your library card, which has your library card number on it. And you'll probably need a magnifying glass to read that number.

## Logging into WV Deli

1. Go to <https://wvdeli.overdrive.com>.



2. In the top right corner, click **Sign In**.
3. The Welcome window appears. From the drop down menu select your library.



4. After selecting your library, enter your **Card Number**. On my library card, that number is on the back, towards the bottom of the card.
5. After you have entered your number, click
6. **Sign In**.
7. You are now able to browse and borrow ebooks and audio books.

## Finding Books

Once you have logged in, you can search for eBooks and audio books.

1. Towards the top of the window, click **Search**.

2. In the search box, start to type the name of the book or author.
3. A list appears as you type. You can click on an item from the list or click the magnifying glass icon.

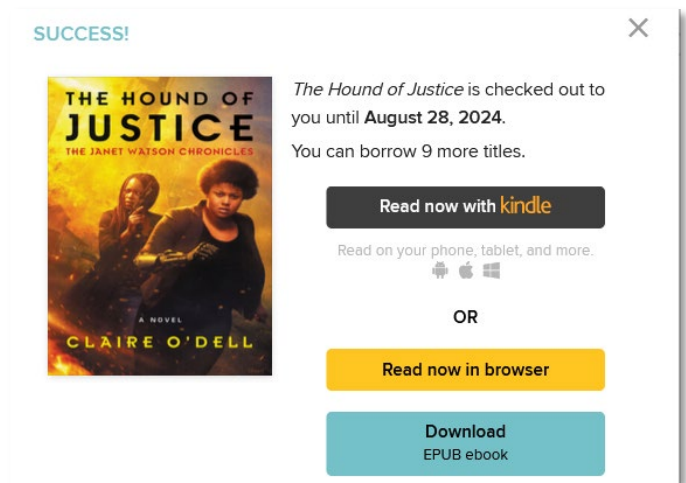
4. A list of books matching your criteria are displayed.

6. Click on the **Borrow** link if you would like to read or listen to the book.
7. You have the option to select how long you would like to have the book. If you are okay with that length, click **Borrow**.

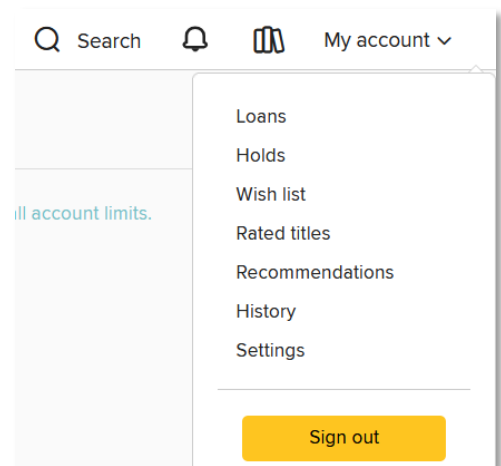

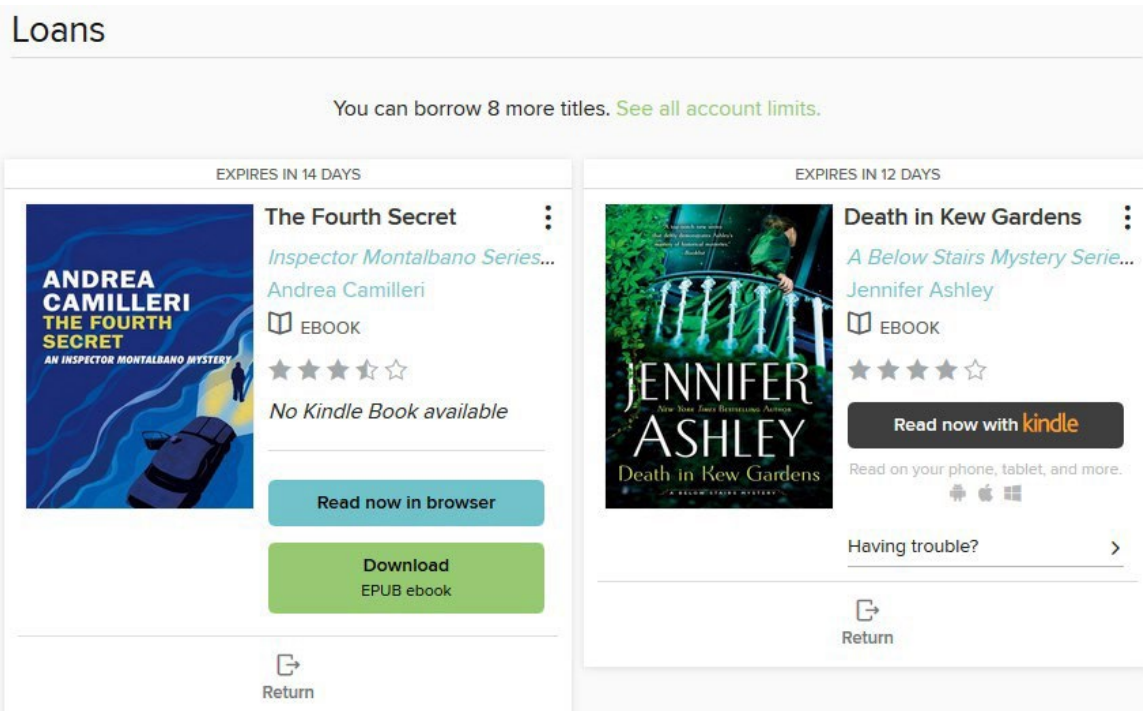


## Finding Your Loans

- From the drop down menu, select **Loans**.



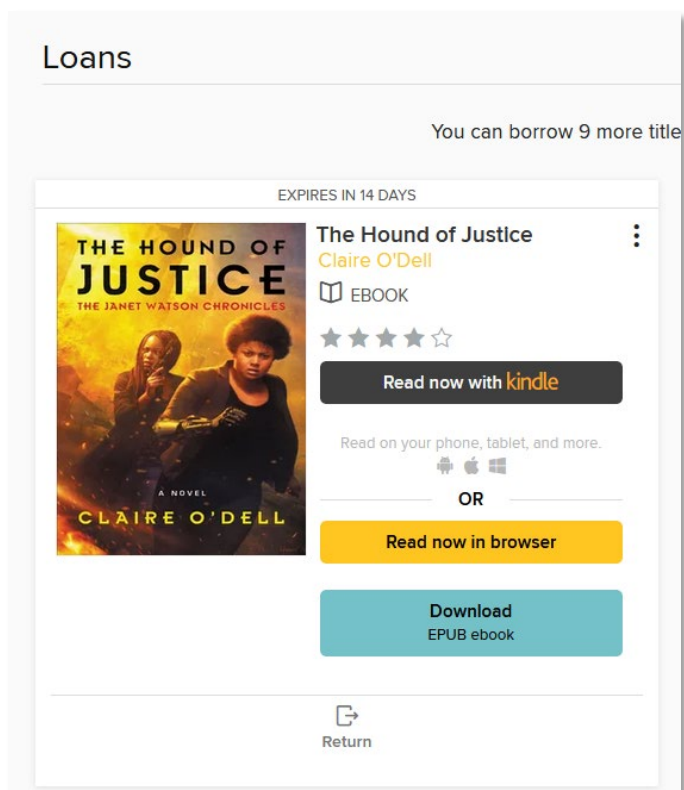
- A list of the books you have checked out is displayed.

1. Go to your loans (See above).
2. Beneath the book you finished, click .



3. Click **Return Title**.
